Mounted Patrol

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Minutes were approved as written. Guest Speaker: Tyler Ray is the emergency coordinator for region 3. He spoke on the Community Emergency Response Team Training, which consists of 20 hours of lecture and hands on in 9 different areas. There will be a train the trainer class in June. He explained what it is and answered questions.
