

The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM. Roll call found Merlin, Randy, Maryanne, Karen, and Vivian (both excused) absent. The minutes were approved as corrected. Add the date of the next meeting to the minutes. Cheryl Parker was welcomed as a new member. Darrell Wallace was introduced as a guest.

SAR: council discussed the mock searches. No decision was reached.

Chris: The Grays Harbor county sheriff seized several horses. A court order was received that no sheriff office employee could harbor the horses. Chris introduced Chuck Groth from Thurston County Parks and Rec. Mr. Groth discussed adopting parts of the CWT and the Tenino to Yelm Trail and told what the up keep would be and what would be required of us if we did adopt a section. Chris also told of places to park when patrolling the CWT. We can park on George Rd; there is room on the shoulder for some trailers. Also we can park behind the Rainier Market and at the Tenino City Park.

Chris also sent around a picture of what radios we will be getting. Each radio is \$199.00 and the collar mike is an additional \$35.00 each. It was moved, seconded and carried to purchase 16 radios with collar mikes for a total of approximately \$4045.00. Chris will get together with Carolyn Aduddell regarding payment.
