

Minutes 2006-06-20

Mounted Patrol

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. Roll call found Marlin, Vivian, Randy, and Maryanne absent. Minutes were approved at written.

TREAS: savings dividend \$0.69; balance in savings \$807.48; check to Carolyn 12.98, web fee 9.97; balance in checking \$5911.06; total account balance \$6718354. Outstanding bills are as follows: copies to Carrie, 4.34; Jeff for paint for Richie Bro., 32.42; radios 4157.96 (this one is already approved). Moved, 2nd, and carried to pay bills.

SPSMSAR lost the check for helping at Richie Bro. in December. Discussion followed about charging them the 10.00 stop payment fee. Moved, 2nd, and carried to stop payment, re-issue, and not charge them.

SAR: Mini-SAR this fall, maybe one of the middle weekends in October. Think about it and see which weekend works best. Does anyone need HELO training? CERT looking for instructors, a sign up sheet was passed around. Starting in 2007, badges will be color coded for quick identification as to what people are trained for. There will be a mandatory training for everyone in the National Incident Command System through the State or FEMA, 100 series and a 700 series, (2 classes to take). There will be a link to the classes from our web site. More information will follow. SAR picnic is coming up on 8/26/06 from 4-7. Location will be announced. Sign up sheet sent around for this also. The Christmas party may be replaced by the picnic. The main interest seemed to be for the picnic and not the Christmas party.
